Report of Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum Collected From Different Stakeholders:

Students Feedback:

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education systems. The interest and participation of students at all levels in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have to play a central role. From the current academic year the college has started online feedback system. We have collected online feedback from our under graduate students and postgraduate students. A special five point scale feedback form on the curriculum is developed. We have received total 113 student's online feedback on the syllabus of the various programmes designed by the University of Mumbai, Mumbai.

On an average 33% students are strongly agree, 71% are agree, 7% are neutral, 2% are disagree with the current syllabus of the various programmes designed by the University of Mumbai, Mumbai.

'Need to update our syllabus' is the common suggestion given by some students and which is important.

Teachers Feedback:

The college is affiliated to the Mumbai University, Mumbai and follows the prescribed curriculum. Still online feedback on curriculum is taken by the respective subject teachers regarding suggestions on improvement of the syllabus. We have received.20 teachers feedback on the curriculum and analyzed.

Here important observation is that 100% teachers are saying the current syllabus properly describes the course whereas 90% teachers are saying that the current syllabus is relevant for the needs of society. As far as research is concern 80% teachers are saying current syllabus offered by University of Mumbai, Mumbai is offering research possibilities.

Some common suggestions given by teachers are noted here

1. Syllabus is very vast please shorten the syllabus and the time is insufficient to complete the syllabus. Please add application oriented courses in curriculum.

Parent Feedback:

The online feedback from the parents is collected on the current syllabus of the various programmes and analyzed. We have received total 62 parent's feedback on the current content of the syllabus. Analysis of the total 62 feedback received from the parents is done as follows:

On an average 37% parents are saying that the syllabus offered to students is excellent and nearly 63% parents are saying it is good where as only 1% parents are saying that we are satisfied with current curriculum offered by Mumbai University, Mumbai.

One of the common suggestion given by parents is Our students are very week in English subject so please make improvement in their English language so that it will be beneficial to students in their future.

Alumni Feedback:

Our alumni are valuable for us. They provide us the inputs regarding improvement in facilities and employability of our students. We appeal our alumni to provide there sincere feedback on curriculum. We have received total 23 alumni online feedback on syllabus designed by Mumbai University, Mumbai. Based on the comments of the alumni, the analysis is done as follows:

On an average 89.56% alumni are agree with the syllabus offered by Mumbai University, Mumbai whereas on an average 10.43% alumni are disagree.
