**Report of Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum Collected From Different Stakeholders:
Students Feedback:**

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education System. The interest and participation of students at all level in both Internal Quality Assurance and External Quality Assurance have to play a central role. To know opinion of students about their curriculum, college has collected online feedback forms from under graduate students and post graduate students. We have received online feedback of 363 students on the syllabus of the various programmes designed by the University of Mumbai, Mumbai.

Opinion of 66.94 % students is good about Depth of the course content where as 28.92 % students says that it is very good. About 61 % students say that The applicability/ Relevance of curriculum constructed is good and that of 30.57 % students say that it is very good. Overall rating for curriculum given by students is good because 60.60 % students has good opinion and 30.85 % students has very good opinion. There is no a student which is unsatisfactory with the curriculum designed by the University of Mumbai.

'More focus required in practical. Adopting digital mode of teaching including E learning module' is one of the suggestion given by a students and which is important.

Teachers Feedback:

The college is affiliated to the Mumbai University, Mumbai and follows the prescribed curriculum. Online feedback on curriculum is taken by the respective subject teachers regarding suggestions on improvement of the syllabus. We have received 17 teachers feedback on the curriculum.


We observe that nearly all alumni have positive opinion about the curriculum designed by Mumbai University.
