

### Health Inspection

#### Report

On the occasion of A women's health cheakup workshop was organized on 14 October 2022 in the collaboration with National Service Scheme, Ladies Welfare committee and Government Rural Hospital Jaitapur. The session began with welcome address by Prof. Barge S. K.

The program was completed in two sessions, morning and afternoon. On the occasion of the inauguration of the first session of the workshop, Mrs. Thakur Desai gave guidance on how to take care of women's health and what measures should be taken to maintain good health.

In the second session, after discussion with the students about her health, Mrs. Thakur Desai madam gave answers to her doubts. On this occasion, BMI and blood tests of the students were conducted. Total of 23 girls and 6 female professors tested blood in this time.

In presidential speech, Vice Principal of the college, Dr. Sanjay Mestry said that the health of women in today's stressful life is being neglected. A statement was made that a healthy diet should be followed.

5. Prevention to Sexual Harassment



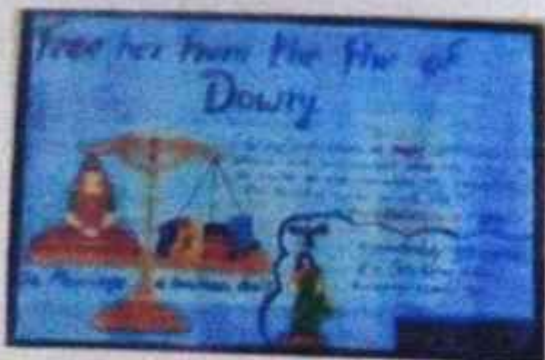

**Date: 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

The United Nations theme for International Women's Day 2023, "DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality" is aligned with the priority theme for the upcoming 67<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW-67), "Innovation and technological change and education in the digital age for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls."

On the occasion of celebration of International Women's Day, our college has conducted one day workshop on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023. The purpose of celebrating Women's Day was sensitization about "Gender equality and women's empowerment". For this program, Ms. Shital Jadhav (Tahasildar, Rajapur) and Mr. Mukesh Nachare (Taekwondo Academy, Rajapur) were present as the resource persons. The session began with welcome address by Dr. Mahanawar K. R. and after this Ms. Kamat M. A. gave the introduction of resource persons.

In the first session, Ms. Shital Jadhav, Tahasildar, Rajapur guided the participant how technology can also help challenge and break gender stereotypes and biases that often limit women's potential. The tips he elaborated on how to self protect and defend are:


**First tip: Prevention is the best self defense**
