Date: 16th March 2023

The United Nations theme for International Women's Day 2023, DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality* is aligned with the priority theme for the upcoming 67th Session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW-67), Innovation and technological change and education in the digital age for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls.

On the occasion of celebration of International Women's Day, our college has conducted one day workshop on Thursday 16th March 2023. The purpose of celebrating Women's Day was sensitization about "Gender equality and women's empowerment". For this program, Ms. Shital Jadhav (Tahasildar, Rajapur) and Mr. Mukesh Nachare (Tackwondo Academy, Rajapur) were present as the resource persons. The session began with welcome address by Dr. Mahanawar K. R. and after this Ms. Karnat M. A. gave the introduction of resource persons.

In the first session, Ms. Shital Jadhav, Tahasildar, Rajapur guided the participant how technology can also help challenge and break gender stereotypes and biases that often limit women's potential. 
