Students Feedback:

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education system. The interest and participation of students at all level in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have to play a central role. To know opinion of students about their curriculum, college has collected online feedback forms from under graduate students and post graduate students. We have received online feedback of 57 students on the syllabus of the various programs designed by the University of Mumbai, Mumbai.

On average 36.8% students says that curriculum implemented is Excellent and that of 43.9% students say that it is good whereas 14% students are only satisfactory with the curriculum implementation.

Opinion/ Suggestions given by students:

1. Provide Guidance of Competitive Exam.
 2. This college is best.
 3. The curriculum is best and implementation of curriculum is excellent.
- All suggestions given by students are important.

Teachers Feedback:

The college is affiliated to the Mumbai University, Mumbai and follows the prescribed curriculum. Online feedback on curriculum is taken from the respective subject teachers regarding suggestions on improvement of the syllabus. We have received 29 teachers feedback on the curriculum.

The response about "The skills developed by students by learning in certificate courses/diploma courses are in pace with social needs is 51.7% is excellent, 34.5% is good, 6.9% is satisfactory and that of 6.9% is poor.

The response about 'Employ-ability is given weightage in design and development of curriculum is 51.7% is excellent, 41.4% is good, 6.9% is satisfactory and no teacher says that it is poor.

The response about 'The library enriched with number of latest reference books as per syllabus' is 44.8% is excellent, 41.4% is good and 10.3% is satisfactory and 3.4% teachers says that it is poor.

The response about 'Modern teaching aids per department are sufficient is 34.5% is excellent, 48.3% is good and 13.8% is satisfactory and that of 3.4% teachers says that it is poor.

The response about 'Motivation of institute for research to undertake major and minor research projects by different funding agencies' is 34.5% is excellent, 48.3% is good, 13.8% is satisfactory and that of 3.4% is poor.

The response about "The teachers are encouraged to organize and participate in seminars/ workshops/ conferences' is 55.2% is excellent, 34.5% is good and 10% is satisfactory.

The response about "The teachers are encouraged to take up consultancy services and establish linkages with industries/other institutions' is 48.3% is excellent, 44.8% is good and 6.9% is satisfactory. Some important suggestions given by teachers are noted here:

1. Minor Research Projects should be given to faculty members.
2. Library should perches new books.

Alumni Feedback:

Opinion of alumni about the college and curriculum is valuable for the college. They provide us the inputs regarding improvement in facilities and employability of our students. We always appeal to our alumni to provide their sincere feedback on curriculum. We have received total of 13 Alumni's online feedback on curriculum of college for academic year 2023-2024.

3. The overall view on the contribution of institute in academics along with emphasis in scientific research is excellent.

Employers Feedback:

An effort was made to receive feedback from various employers who have employed learners from this college. For this purpose the online feedback form on curricula is constructed and circulated among the various employers. Then these forms are being filled by the authorities of various organizations who employed the learners. Then all these responses from various employers were collected and analyzed by feedback committee.

As many as 8 responses have been received from the employers which are on the quality of the curricula studied by the employee in the college.

The response about 'Curriculum designed provides adequate knowledge and skill for employability' is 100% is excellent. The response about 'Involvement of prominent individuals from industries, other universities and research institutes in design of need based curriculum' is as 75% excellent, 25% is good. The response about 'Communication skills & readiness to learn new skills' is 37.5% is excellent, 62.5% is good.

The response about 'Efficiency of working as a part of a team to shoulder extra responsibilities' is 37.5% is excellent, 62.54% is good.

The response about 'Capacity to take initiative in work and exhibit leadership qualities' is 37.5% is excellent, 62.5% is good.

No common suggestions and opinion given by the Employers:
